Leeuwin Ocean Adventure is a Western Australian not for profit company and registered charity.



Conceived, designed, built, owned and operated by Leeuwin Ocean Adventure for Western Australian youth, STS Leeuwin II is Australia's largest sail training tall ship. Despite our geographically dispersed and smaller population in WA, voyage programs have been delivered to more young people on STS Leeuwin II than on any other sail training tall ship operating in Australia.

Accessibility to the ship's programs is critically important. Leeuwin Ocean Adventure's diverse voyage programs are complemented by overnight camps and daytime activities alongside in Fremantle, day sails and unique weekend voyage adventures.

STS Leeuwin II is the only sail training tall ship in Western Australia, purpose built to challenge and inspire young men and women to be the best they can be.

58 organisations, service clubs and individuals contributed **\$426k** towards youth voyage fares.


27 organisations gave pro bono and discounted goods and services towards the maintenance and repair of STS Leeuwin II worth over **\$100k**.
